



Vote early in person

☐ Register

- You can pre-register up to 20 days before Election Day at mnvotes.gov or
- Register when you vote by
 1. Showing proof of residency
 - For example, a current and valid Minnesota ID or driver's license
 - A list of all proof of residence options are available at mnvotes.gov
 2. Have a registered voter in your precinct vouch for you

☐ Find your early voting locations at hennepincounty.gov/elections

- Hennepin County residents can vote early at the Hennepin County Government Center or local election office
- Check with your local election office for locations and hours

☐ Know what's on your ballot

- View your sample ballot at mnvotes.gov/myballot

☐ Vote!

- Check with your local election office for early voting hours
- You don't need to bring proof of residence if you are pre-registered
- If you're unsure you're registered, check at mnvotes.gov
- You will be given an absentee ballot application to fill out before you receive your ballot
